Everyone welcome

Underway:

- Considering possibilities of three connected visitor hubs at Watermeadows, Ewe Pens and Lodge Park, to include accessible loos (none currently on whole estate)
- Project to improve the network of estate paths, ensuring greater resilience and accessibility
- 15km of accessible routes
- 45km of paths and tracks across the estate

Considering:

- Car parking ticket valid across the estate
- Increased car park capacity to remove pressure on village and support ease of visit, potential for electric charging and covered spaces for trampers
- Five nature and historic landscape trails established, inc. new access to parkland by river
- Other potential components in future e.g. cycling
