I thought it would be useful for me to contact you with an update on our progress on the Sherborne Brook project and the next steps.

- 1. Following our session on the 9<sup>th</sup> of July I shared both the notes Caroline took and the Sherborne Parish Council notes with senior colleagues from the Trust. I was grateful for both the session and the feedback provided.
- 2. We have been given a clear steer from management to progress with submitting a planning application for the work this summer and Tim is looking to submit the application on the Cotswold District Council portal this week. We expect it to take around a week for it to appear on the portal for people to comment.
- Continue to work with Matt Hemsworth, JBA, regarding the flood risk modelling.
- 4. We will look to provide a full and comprehensive response to the list of community questions regarding the project this week.
- 5. We will produce a project specific edition of the newsletter within the next fortnight.
- 6. We had a very productive session on Saturday morning digging out the grips and channels in Ragged Copse. We are planning on holding a further session in September to work on the Grips in Moors Copse. Tim will be leading on this and road run off works going forward.
- 7. We have a meeting with representatives from Historic England this week to discuss a funding bid for removing existing silt and aquatic vegetation from the Broadwaters and Narrows.
